

Superior 'Hedge Start' Guard

Cheap, quick & easy

Allows air circulation around the plant

Branches through the guard

No need to remove (photo-degradable)

No fixings required

Bury base when planting



Hedgestart – 'how to use'

1. Push the plant into the guard ensuring about 75% of the guard is buried.
2. Nip up the base of the guard and plant tree and guard together so that approx 100 mm of the guard is in the ground.
3. Consolidate the ground well to ensure good contact and grip.
4. To encourage the plant to bush out cut it back so that the top is level with the top of the guard
5. Occasional checks should be made and any that have worked loose should be firmed up again. On the most exposed sites or in soils that have poor grip, it may be necessary to use a cane.
